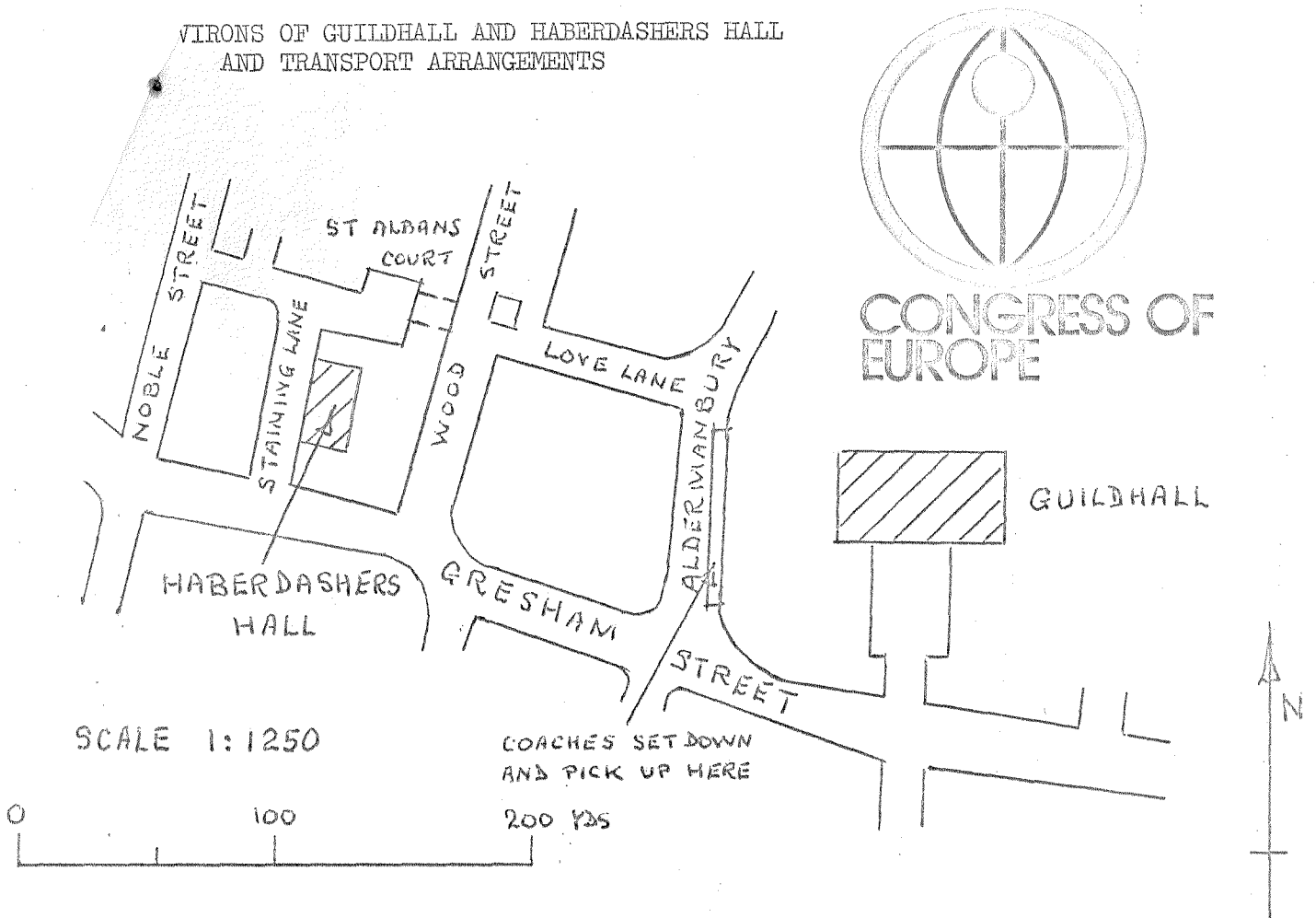

AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS



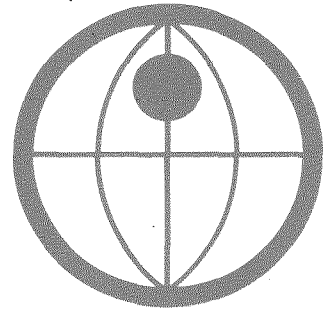
1. Delegates will be picked up each morning at their hotels by coaches and taken to Guildhall. Time of departure from each hotel will be shown at the Reception Desk.
2. On arrival at Aldermanbury (see plan above) delegates are asked to disembark with all their belongings without delay, so that their coach can move away and make room for another one. Guides will be available for the short walk to Guildhall.
3. Coaches conveying delegates to luncheon on Friday and Saturday, and back to their hotels after each day's session, will leave from the same place in Aldermanbury. Again delegates are asked to board their coaches without delay.
